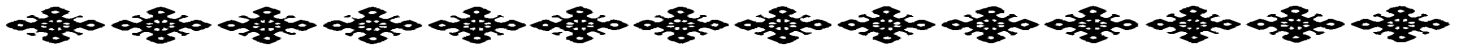

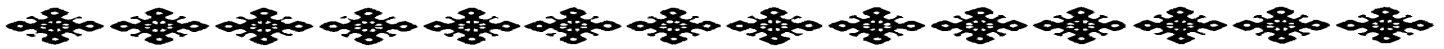

**PASCHAL BASKET** It is customary to bless various foods - especially ones we have fasted from - on Pascha. Many people make up a basket with a candle. You can read about paschal foods here: <https://saintnicholasburton.org/files/PaschalBasketPdf.pdf> The simple blessing of foods will take place on Holy Saturday, April 11 after the 10 am Liturgy. The Paschal blessing of foods will take place after the 10:30 pm Paschal services on Holy Saturday, April 11. Blessing will take place in the fellowship hall. It is a tradition at St Nicholas Church to share some of your foods after the evening service.

**PASCHAL VESPERS** It is custom at this service on Pascha morning (Agape Vespers) - April 12 at 11 am - to read the Gospel in various languages. The languages that are already taken are French, German, Macedonian, Romanian, Russian, Slovak, and Ukrainian.

**ARTOS FOR PASCHA** If you would like to make the artos (bread), please see Fr Matthew.

**LENTEN PRAYER PARTNER** At Pascha, you can let your prayer partner know you remembered them in prayer during Lent by giving them a card or a red egg or sending them a card.

**COIN BOXES** during Lent we collect coins to help support the Orthodox missions here in the US and around the world through the Orthodox Christians Mission Center (OCMC). Boxes are found on the tables in the church hall. Please be generous!
