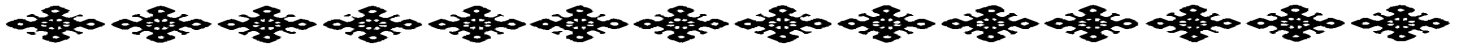

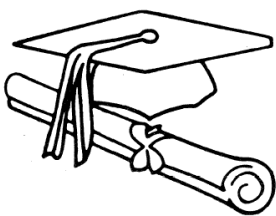

When we come to venerate the Cross after the Divine Services Father Matthew will offer this greeting and we respond: "Indeed, He is Risen!"
