TROPARIA

People: My mouth will speak wisdom, the thoughtfulness of my heart - understanding.

Reader: **Hear these, all the nations, give ear, all inhabitants of the world.** *(Ps 48:1)*

People: My mouth will speak wisdom, the thoughtfulness of my heart - understanding.

Reader: **My mouth will speak wisdom,**

People: the thoughtfulness of my heart - understanding.

Priest: Wisdom!

Reader: **The reading is from the epistle of the holy apostle Paul to the Hebrews (7:26-8:2)**

Priest: Let us attend!

Reader: Brethren, such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens; who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for his own sins and then for the people's, for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself. For the law appoints as high priests men who have weakness, but the word of the oath, which came after the law, appoints the Son who has been perfected forever. Now this is the main point of the things we are saying: We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens, a Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man.

Priest: Peace to you, reader!

Reader: And to your spirit! Alleluia in the second tone. Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!

People: Tone 2 Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!

Reader: Attend, my people, to my law, incline your ear to the words of my mouth. *(Psalm 77:1)*

People: Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!

Reader: I will open parables in my mouth, I will voice problems from of old. *(Ps 77:2)*

People: Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!
